



### Raw sewage at Ampilatwatja



With the government refusing to fund jobs for local people in communities, services are suffering badly.

3000L of raw sewage was dumped onto the ground at the local tip. This is only 800 metres from the local school. The three Aboriginal staff refused these orders and demanded support to dispose of it properly. Two contractos were brought in to dump it.
